Founded in 1980, Stony Brook University Medical Center is the Tertiary Care Medical Center and a Level I Trauma Center for Suffolk County. The Medical Center is part of the SUNY System and is supported by a comprehensive School of Medicine and several other Health Science Education specialties.

Stony Brook operates a comprehensive EMS service that provides EMT and Paramedic staffed inter-facility ambulances and first response vehicles in cooperation with several EMS services throughout Suffolk County. As part of their mission Stony Brook staffs Paramedics for the MedEvac helicopters in cooperation with the Suffolk County Police Department.

Other services of the Department of Emergency Medicine include the County Medical Control Center, EMT and Paramedic Training Programs, Emergency Medicine Research Program, and an Emergency Department staffed by 50 Physicians who are Emergency Medicine and Pediatric Specialists. Stony Brook also staffs the Emergency Department at Peconic Bay Medical Center. The Chair of the Department of Emergency Medicine, Dr. Mark Henry also serves as the NY State EMS Medical Director.

The Department of Emergency Medicine is very active on an international level including an affiliated EMS training center at Halla College in Jeju Island, South Korea.
