Position Description/Typical Duties

An employee in this position will select and plan for and supervises the training of local Emergency Preparedness organizations in subjects such as radiation detection, rescue and emergency medical services. Will review the quality and adequacy of training programs periodically to improve their effectiveness. Will maintain liaison with other emergency preparedness services and public and private agencies and coordinates the development of their operational procedures and the training of their personnel in emergency preparedness operations to achieve good coverage and effective performance in time of disaster. Will serve as an advisor on the selection and implementation of training courses.

Minimum Qualifications

Completion of sixty (60) credits from a college with federally-authorized accreditation or registration by New York State, and two (2) years of paid experience in developing and conducting emergency services, public safety and/or security training programs, one year of which must have been in a public agency.
