JOB DESCRIPTION SUMMARY: The position of EMT, EMT-CC and EMT-P for Fishers Island shall remain in a ready status during the duration of deployment ready to respond promptly to all requests for medical assistance as directed. Members will function at the level of (EMT only) while deployed and work in conjunction with the on island physician and NYS DOH and Suffolk County REMAC policies, procedures and protocols. Prehospital care providers shall ensure that all ambulances and responder vehicles are service ready and fully stocked, all patient care devices are clean and in working order and all supplies are in date

Paid staff will report directly to the Riverhead Volunteer Ambulance, District Manager and perform any and all other tasks assigned by Fishers Island Fire Department staff.

REQUIREMENTS:

Experience Recommended: Two (2) years prior active 911 experience as an EMT-CC or Paramedic.

Skills, Knowledge and Abilities:

Current NYS EMT, EMT-CC or Paramedic Certification Current ACLS & PALS preferred Suffolk REMSCO Credentialed Current CPR-Basic Life Support EVOC or CEVO preferred.

Interpersonal skills in dealing with volunteers, other employees, other health care workers, patients and their families. Must have the ability to work both with others and independently.

Language: Must be able to read and write in English well enough to read and prepare reports, communicate effectively with peers, personnel reporting to this position, outside associates and the public. Proficiency in other languages is a plus. Physical: Must be able to lift a minimum of 125 lbs, as per NYS requirements of an emergency medical care provider. Pass a mandatory department physical with drug screening.

License: Must possess a valid New York State Drivers license at all times.

Driver license must be free of DWI convictions in last 10 years, excessive moving violations, or other significant convictions or restrictions.
