ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Provides initial first-aid treatment or emergency medical care through FD 911 ambulance service at the site of an occurrence. Render pre-hospital emergency care as an ALS provider as outlined by New York State Department of Health and Suffolk County Emergency Medical Services Guidelines. Direction is received from an administrative supervisor or higher level professional personnel who review work through Quality Improvement Programs and online communications with Medical Control. Does related work as required.

QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

Candidates for this position must have completed the Suffolk Regional Emergency Medical Advisory committee's (REMAC) Advanced Life Support credentialing process at the time of appointment and must complete all protocol and policy updates throughout employment in the position.

Possession of an Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic certificate or Emergency Medical Technician- Critical Care certificate issued by the New York State Department of Health. Candidates are required to possess the appropriate New York State driver's license.

(Candidates must maintain the appropriate Emergency Medical Technician Certificates (NYS/REMSCO), and driver's license throughout employment in this position.)
