MISSION: To provide open dialogue between the 6 member agencies, East Hampton Dispatch and Southampton Hospital with the goal of constantly finding ways to improving the 911 Emergency Medical Services provided to the approximate 430 square miles we serve.

NOTED ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

First founded in 1990 as East End Ambulance Association as a forum of communication to help facilitate local education and training. EEAA was renamed East End Ambulance Coalition in 2004 and their mission expanded to include a greater use of their teamwork.

2004 – A mutual aid plan that included the ability for any EMT from any of the 6 agencies to assist any of the member agencies after the 1st reactivation of a call.

2014/2015 – East End TAC Ambulance, which provided summer season dual ambulance agency dispatching during daytime calls.

2016 – Drafted/Implemented a standardized Controlled Substance Plan with Southampton Hospital to be used by all member agencies and 3 additional agencies of Eastern Southampton Town.

2017 – Became the largest multi-agency territory in Suffolk County to move to a single platform E-PCR documentation system.
