Overview: This course is designed to educate advanced life support providers on the core concepts of advanced airway management.

Objectives:

- Articulate the role of invasive airway management including its risks and benefits.
- Demonstrate management of airways with non-invasive and invasive skills to facilitate and maximize ventilation and oxygenation.
- Execute clinical decision making regarding the appropriate use of Rapid Sequence Intubation.
- Comprehension of invasive airway management and its indications, contraindications, alternatives and mastery of BLS airway management skills.
- Proficiency in clinical assessment of difficult or potentially difficult airways, strategies to manage such and failed airway algorithms.
- Competency in direct and video laryngoscopy techniques, and assisted devices to maximize first pass success.
- Understanding of the pharmacology and pharmacodynamics of RSI medications, including proper and safe use.
- Preparation, pre-intubation resuscitation and optimization, mitigation of peri-intubation complications and post intubation management.
