## Welcoming veterans and service members to join Northwell Health

### Program Overview:

Northwell Health's Center for Emergency Medical Services (CEMS) is proud to offer a paid, comprehensive program, in partnership with our Center for Learning & Innovation, and Military Liaison Services, to support veterans and service members who want to jumpstart a career to become an Emergency Medical Technician (EMT).

The Train & Earn EMT Certification Program is a 15 week, on-the-job, paid training course designed for eligible veterans and service members to receive didactic and experiential learning as an Emergency Medical Technician, where you can earn \$20.00 per hour/40 hours per week for the time spent in training. Northwell Health is providing a full scholarship to all who participate in this training program.

Upon successful completion of the Train & Earn EMT Certification Program and passing the EMT exam (inclusive of passing the required Physical Agility Test), each participant has an opportunity to be promoted to a full-time EMT.

### Eligibility requirements and program commitments:

Our program is a paid training program for veterans and service members who:

- Have earned a state-endorsed high school diploma or HSE/TASC (formerly GED certificate).
- Have a driver's license valid in New York State (without violations or points).
- Provide an employment commitment to work as an EMT at Northwell for at least one year, upon successful completion of the program and EMT certification.
- Receive a passing grade for a Physical Agility Test, administered by Northwell Health Workforce Safety.
